
Have you attended camp or programming at YMCA Camp Eberhart? Then you're an alumnus!

Day Camp Stay-Over

Campers ages 9+ have the option of staying overnight. On Wednesday night campers will stay in a lodge or cabin after an evening of full camp activities. Wednesday Stay-Over requires registration prior to start of your week of camp.

DAY CAMP

ASTRO CAMP

Session 6: July 24-29, 2022 • Ages 9+

YMCA Camp Eberhart enjoys one of the longest-running astronomy programs in the entire country and has been visited by professional astronomers from coast to coast. The unique program is designed for campers ages 9–15 that are eager to discover, and ready to begin the great adventure of exploring the universe through stargazing, telescoping, and astrophotography.

YMCA Camp Eberhart is fortunate to enjoy an 18" Obsession telescope, an 11" C11 telescope, and a fleet of 8" Dobsonian telescopes. Combined with our top-notch astronomers, campers will take an exciting journey through the universe.

The Difference Between Astro Camp and the Astronomy Program

You can sign up for 1 hour of astronomy all summer long, but true lovers of the stars should sign-up for Astro Camp, where they will receive many hours of astronomy all day and night.

Astro Camp is a week-long program with its main focus on the great adventure of exploring the universe. Campers stay up after dark, stargazing, telescoping, and looking at astrophotography.

Cabin Life

Campers at YMCA Camp Eberhart get to unplug and stay in facilities ranging from traditional stone cabins to temperature-controlled lodges. There are typically 4-6 counselors per cabin providing leadership and friendship to our campers.

Dining Services

Our professional food-service team provides 3 meals each day. We have a breakfast bar at every breakfast as well as a sandwich and salad bar at lunch and dinner. Our food service director has been with us for many years and has a passion for making healthy and delicious meals. We can accommodate most allergies, and we are also proud to be a nut-free facility.

Health Services

Our "Say-Ahh-Inn" health facility employs a health officer that lives on-site and manages the health and medical needs of all campers; including bumps, bruises, and medication distribution. Our entire staff team is First Aid and CPR certified and trained in camp healthcare policies. We also have established health service policies that are reviewed annually by a certified medical professional.

Camp Store

Kids burn a lot of calories at camp and our camp store is a long-standing tradition. Campers can order snacks for rest periods, and ice cream during open periods, up to 4 total treats per day. During breakfast and lunch, our gift store is open to purchase camp apparel and other items. Purchases are made through the camper's store account.

YMCA Camp Eberhart's equestrian programs combine safe and healthy horses, trained staff, and excellent facilities to create a positive atmosphere where campers can focus on horses. These programs allow our campers the opportunity to advance their horseback riding skills, expand their horsemanship knowledge, and enjoy riding with friends. Both Western and English riding styles are offered.

Ranch Camp is all horses all day! Campers will not only advance their riding skills in all areas but also learn how to care for their horse beyond the arena. This includes how the farrier, chiropractor, dentist, vet and our staff work together to maintain a strong, healthy herd. Campers must be a minimum of 9 years old and have prior riding experience.

Experiencing Camp

Although our specialty camps focus on astronomy and horseback riding, these campers also get to experience traditional camp activities just like everyone else; swimming, archery, campfires, and of course, the opportunities to make lifelong friends!









TEEN PROGRAMMING

Camp makes growing up fun for all ages, including teens. YMCA Camp Eberhart has three programs designed to prepare teens to become amazing leaders in all walks of life, and possibly even Camp Eberhart staff. Participating in these programs will give your teenagers great experiences to list on their future resumes. With service projects, training, and leadership, their experience will be a step-up above the rest!

Service Crew

Sessions: 1, 2, 3 Ages: 14-17

As a part of "the Crew," campers get their hands dirty, work hard, and get a glimpse into behind the scenes projects at camp. Paired with an afternoon of traditional camp activities, campers will experience what it means to have a servant's heart and lead by example through identifying projects to better camp, such as repairs, painting, landscaping, etc., and working along side camp staff to create a plan and complete the task. Campers can earn community service hours for their participation in this program.

Leadership Core (LC) is for teenagers entering 11th grade and is designed to give them a camp experience tailored to youth in leadership.

Leadership Core includes off-site adventures where campers work to develop leadership and team building skills, as well as an on-site service project, and hands-on training in the areas of communication, teen leadership, environmental stewardship, and community service. This is a 2-week program.
